Shalema has lived at Karekare all her life. Has work for Community Waitakere as Community Developer.

Specialising in Community disaster Readiness.

A short video was played of the disaster of what happened during the disaster.

Presentation a mix of various issues.

Population: approx. 300.

AEM: She/It will be all right and AEM will look after it. This is not always correct.

But AEM have to look after the Base issues and then it is up to persons within the area to organise themselves (Community).

One Model,

Core Resilience Team: (Looks after the Initial community Disasters response network between disasters)

Disaster Co-ordination Team: Mainly same Team as Core Resilience Team, but may have members that do not want to go to lots of committee meetings but in a disaster, they are ideal as they have a background in emergency response. (Possibly ex Firefighters and others members)

WhatsApp: (Radio's) used for connection to all contacts within the area, Provided the Internet is operational and accessible.

Good Distribution of Points of Contact: Collection of where damage is in local area.

Hyper local teams: One or two persons in every street, acting as a co-ordination point. This feeds up information up to Disaster Co-Ordination Team (Just to get response going)

Process: **1:** Check your Household. **2:** Check your Neighbours. **3:** Put Something White on your Letterbox/Fence if OK. Go to Points of Contact and advise Situation.

Community Building selected for **support centres** were not available (Surf Club Had a Slip, Fire Station- Needed space due to being out the previous night and a School was not allowed to use it by education department and other activities)

Support Centres were then located in areas, from yard of a property, by a power pole (where safe).

8.1h

Members of AREC must also be members of NZART. Non-amateurs may be Associate members of AREC. This will allow non-NZART members to take part in AREC activities, but they may not hold office in AREC or its Groups. They are modelled on those contained in the separate Council remit proposing changes to rules regarding the membership of NZART branches. Council believes that this provides an appropriate balance – giving AREC Groups a larger pool from which to recruit members while keeping the organisation under the control of NZART.

(c) A Branch may, by its constitution, provide separately for the admission of its own members and the levying of a subscription additional to the Association subscription, but must not admit to **full** membership any persons who hold a New Zealand Amateur Station Licence unless those persons are also members of the Association.

(d) Branches may also have associate members that shall be entitled to attend meetings and enjoy such other rights as the branch committee may prescribe, but who shall have no right to vote or to hold office in the club.

2. That clauses 6.3(d) to 6.3(f) be renumbered 6.3(c) to 6.3(g)


