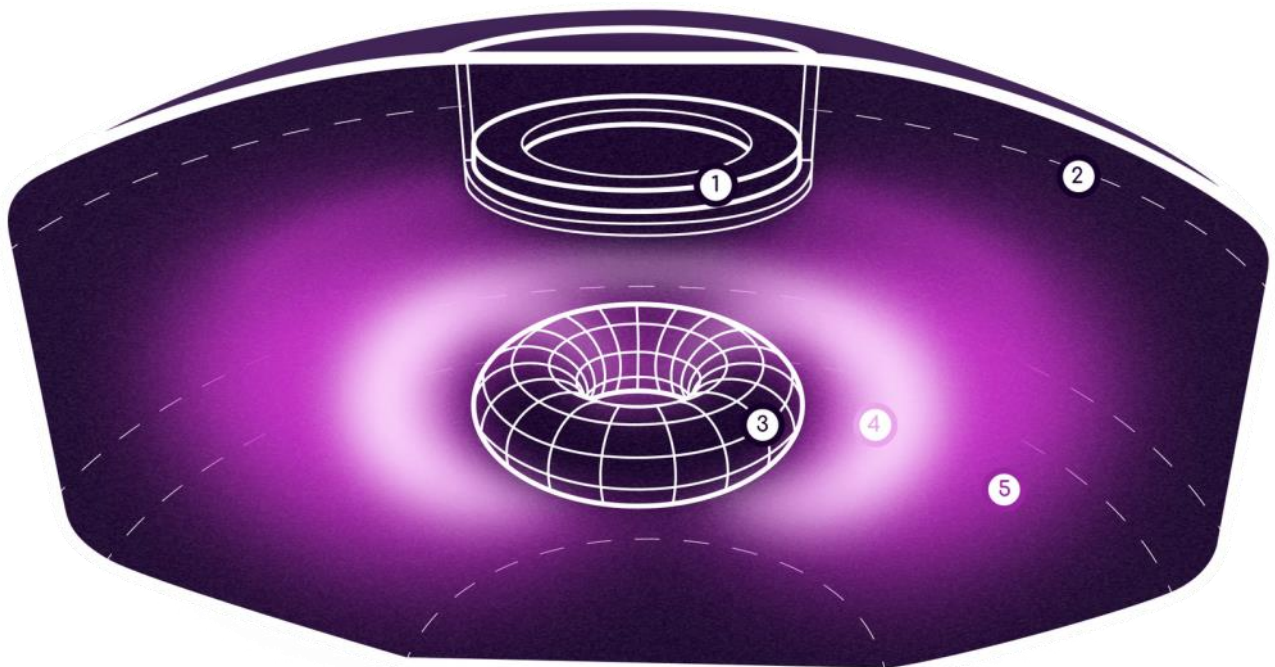

VOICE EXERCISE SCHEDULE CHANGE

Effective Sunday 2nd November, 2025 the Alpine Fault Network HF voice exercise will be conducted per below;

- 0830 NZT 5.360 MHz USB
- 1230 NZT 7.115 MHz LSB
- 2030 NZT 3.605 MHz LSB

The above changes have been made to give us the best opportunity for NVIS communication over the entire country at this time of the year.

Please be aware that the times are mostly set due to propagation predictions rather than for convenience. Having said that, base stations may find the morning and evening times convenient, and field stations the lunchtime is ok.

For now, members can check in on more than one net, however if participation increases significantly, I may ask for future months that you limit checking in to only one.

To ensure your station is exercised on all three frequencies, select a different net each month.

VOICE EXERCISE FORMAT CHANGE

The format of the AFN voice nets has changed; <https://afn.org.nz/exercise/voice/>

Significantly, the net control station will take check-ins and complete the roll call on a per region basis. You will not need to wait for all stations to check in.

Regions are handled North to South starting at Northland and finishing with Southland.

As soon as you have transmitted your report, you are good to close down.

Please also note the information requested in your report has changed. It has been streamlined to increase efficiency. Please do not transmit any information not requested.

The order in which you transmit the information is also important.

If you want to provide additional information or ask the net control station a question, append the words TRAFFIC ON HAND FOR NET CONTROL to your report.

Stay listening until the Net has concluded, awaiting Net Control to call you back.

60 METRE POWER LIMIT

A reminder that the Amateur Radio GURL prescribes a maximum of 11.8dBW EIRP on 60 metres.

A low wire antenna over poor ground is likely to present a loss rather than gain, so transmitter output power between 15-20 watts would be ok for most implementations.

Please take extra care to ensure the prescribed limit is not exceeded.

TRADING TABLE

Currently our Trading Table is only open on meeting nights.

The Trading Table is now on line. Navigate your way to our new look web site at <https://aucklandvhf.org/> and click on TRADING TABLE (the most right hand tab).

Wait a few seconds and the on-line version of the Trading Table will pop up.

From here you can browse the various sections, dig deeper to look at what's available and even place your order online.

If you prefer to just look at the Trading Table List, just hover your mouse pointer over the TRADING TABLE and a drop down list will appear.

From this you can access the Trading Table list and download it in .PDF form.

The Trading Table List is a comprehensive list of items the club has had in stock and may still have. **The price list on some items may have also changed as the list has not been updated.**

A lot of the items on the list are **NOT** loaded into the Web system as stock has not been validated. If there is **NO** quantity shown, please send an email the Trading Table with the part number and quantity of item(s) you require, and we will get back to you if they are available or not and the price.

NOTE: As this is a club, it may be two week before actual validation of items, but an acknowledgement should be sent and advised of approx. time delay for validation. The items will then be added to the internet system and these should be able to be ordered online.

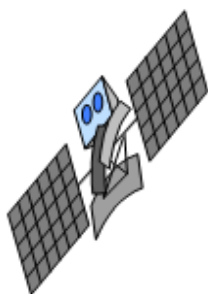
Payment can be by either Credit Card, or Direct Debit to our account.

Payments by Credit Card.

- **All items sold will be in NZ\$.**
- **Conversion to NZ\$ for purchases , to purchases money for refunds will be at the normal bank rate at the time of the transaction. This may be at a different rate.**
- **All items sold using credit card will contain a surcharge. This amount is taken out by the EFTPOS supplier before the money is deposited into the club's account. This surcharge covers the cost of the Credit Card processing.**
- **With refunds, the club can only refund the amount the club has received into our bank account. The club cannot pay back the surcharge, as the club had not received the money.**
