George does a great job tracking our finances. He must spend hours every week juggling accounts, and Basil Orr does a welcome job scrutineering our accounts each year, and offering advice.

For me, it has been a pleasure and a privilege being on the committee. We are like a family now. Thank you, team.

Vaughan has stood down from the repeater trustee role, which he has handled for many years. Simon Bridger and Murray Freeth-Edwards are looking after them now.

Vaughan advises that the Brynderwyn tower is needing attention, so there's another task for the new committee.

With Klondyke and the team of supporters for keeping the system operational, I would like to thank Keith ZL1BQE, Harry ZL1BK and Dave ZL1DL for their work on keeping the site operational plus all others who assist with the maintenance.

#### Auckland VHF Group Inc. Treasurers Report 2025.

For the past financial year 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025, the club has made a net income loss of \$11,219, compared with a profit of \$11,419 for 2024.

This is due to Klondyke maintenance, insurance with a higher General Liability Premium for 670, equipment purchased for 670 and a donation from Dave and Margaret Dingley to cover this expense. Contact power at Klondyke has gone up but recovery from a third party is helping in that matter. Total income is down \$7,000, due to the club received two bequests the previous year, which are in term deposit at present.

The club has 2 term investments and are due to be renewed on 30 November and 20 December. These are presently at 4.0% for 6 Months but at present looks like they will drop to 3.4% for 6 months. I expect that the interest will drop more slowly now.

There are a few issues that would improve the club's balance sheet, and these will need to be looked at in the new year. The club will need to look at the facilities it has and the agreements with them. There are some due in the future years that will need updating, and some that we cannot update and even access.

The 670 repeater has this year had a licence to occupy signed, which probably is the first time since the VHF Group installed the repeater in the location.

Over the last couple of years we have seen the membership steadily declining, and not coming to meetings. It would be good to get input from the members as to what they want, and also to assist the committee to take the load off them.

Insurance is slowly increasing, and the club has had to update our General liability cover for the 670 site. That also gives members of the club working on equipment for the club, some cover for possible issues.

Power for the clubrooms and Brynderwyn are comparable to last year, but the external user at Klondyke is using power, about the same as the club and tenants. We are charging them through a check meter, installed by Franklin power who replaced the old mechanical meter. It is planned to remote read the meter and then charge them from the remote with the occasional validation when a person visits the site.

All my information is on a NAS, and have two separate backup disks. These need to be backed up occasionally. These have most of the files on for the club.

It would be good to get someone to assist with this work, rather than leave it so it becomes an issue if anything happens to me or anyone else.

If I could find an application that will do a membership database with most of the other requirements it would be a nice to have without too much cost.

I also wish to thank my reviewer for his diligence in looking at the accounts.

I thought I was going to be better this year but it looked a bit worse, but time was also an issue. I will be happy to continue as treasurer for another year.

Note: 01: Trading Table.

The Trading Table is an important part of the Club, as it provides some additional income for the club to be able to keep running. Suggestion has been to closes the trading table, but there are items on the trading table that are required and hard to get.

An online system needs to be set up to sell items and keep stock levels accurate. I will look at that when I get time. With that, the club needs to have a better log of sales items, and accountability.

**Overseas orders** have been blocked from the payment device as costings and shipping have increased substantially and orders are not adding shipping onto them.

I will look into getting various connectors that are required and have them added to the Trading Table.

The Trading Table is to be available during Club and Committee Meeting nights, along with other times as arranged. If specific items are required then contact the trading table via the web site using <u>trading-table@aucklandvhf.org</u> and put your enquiry there.

#### Note 02: Beacons and Repeater Licences.

The club has to pay for Repeater, Links and Beacon Licenses. These are different from your own Personal GURL licenses, which is a free licence.

To keep them active, donations for sponsorship for these licenses are being received from members and users of the frequencies. I want to thank **ALL the Sponsors** of the Beacons and Repeaters.

There are some beacons/repeaters that are off the air at present. The beacons are on the Air from the clubrooms until they can be re-installed into the Beacon Hut in the Waitakere Ranges. The club is also looking for sites to cover specific area's including central Auckland/Waitemata Harbour area.

#### Note 03: Subscriptions

This year subscription at the club has dropped with a few members leaving the club to go to other clubs. Some have moved or changed to clubs closer to their home.

The club executive is wanting to get more members involved in the club. Members need to get out and try and look at getting new members, to carry on with Amateur Radio.

The club needs to find more income as subscriptions are not covering outgoings, that means looking at extra income from our assets will be needed to keep them in good operational condition.

Subscriptions are payable at the moment by; in person at a meeting, Direct bank transfer, Credit Card via Web Subscription Page.

Subscriptions will also need to be increased this year as they were missed last year, at the AGM.

#### Note 04: D-Star Operation

DSTAR: The D/Star repeater and controller is located at Klondyke Repeater hut is owned by Laurie ZL1ICU / Marlene ZL1MYL. This has had some issues with the UPS for the Controller, and been replaced with the Backup UPS. The 2 Meter D/Star is operational and the 70cm D/Star repeater has been removed for repair.

Note 05: Repeater and Beacon License Donations.

Note 07: Depreciation for 2025,

Depreciation has not changed and is set out in the deprecation listing of assets.

Without a Breakdown of the equipment, and costs, I have not changed the depreciation value of the Assets. The assets need to be defined in more detail to be able to modify the correct asset rate.

New equipment has been installed into 670 Ruaotewhenua (Waitakere), including filters, Lightning arrestors, and antennas.

Note 08: GST Status.

The Auckland VHF Group is not registered for GST, and that these accounts are GST inclusive.

Note: 09: Insurance.

This is a requirement for the club to have insurance for the Club. The type of insurance for the club requires is for buildings and other indemnity for members and the clubs.

Looking at what the Canterbury fires a couple of years ago, and the costs to cover the issues can be quite substantial and will take time to recover from them.

The Auckland VHF Group has for fire and replacement of the Clubrooms, some Indemnity for members and committee, and have also had to upgrade our public liability insurance substantially due to the updated installation of 670 repeater into the new location at Ruaotewhenua (Waitakere Ranges) and new agreement. Insurance cover will be approximately \$3,300.00 this year.

#### Note 10: Maintenance of Klondyke.

There was the Maintenance on the Klondyke tower to replace the Ladder and Cable Tray, this has been completed.

There is still painting of the tower, cable tray replacement and antenna refurbishment. The original quote for painting is in the order of \$64,000. This does not include antennas and cable trays. Assistance and fund raising is needed by the club and members to complete this project.

The club cannot fund this out of the present funds, as well as keep all other activities operational.

#### Note11: Variance Liabilities.

These are Forward Payments/Pre-Paid items for the 2025-2026 year. Included in them are subscriptions, pre-paid Repeater and Beacon Licences.

- Conversion to NZ\$ for purchases , to purchases money for refunds will be at the normal bank rate at the time of the transaction. This may be at a different rate.
- All items sold using credit card will contain a surcharge. This amount is taken out by the EFTPOS supplier before the money is deposited into the club's account. This surcharge covers the cost of the Credit Card processing.
- With refunds, the club can only refund the amount the club has received into our bank account. The club cannot pay back the surcharge, as the club had not received the money.
